SHORT DESCRIPTION

As climate change and environmental challenges is the eTwinning theme of 2020, our project aims at enabling students to live sustainably in order to counteract climate change and other environmental challenges. Through our project we want to open our students' eyes to the fact that even at a young age they already make a choice when it comes to living environmentally consciously. Since global warming is a crucial, threatening and imminent process which demands fast action our students should become aware of its implications and develop strategies to tackle climate change.

The main objective of the project is to motivate students to lead environmentally friendly lifestyles by undertaking activities in different areas in order to prepare them to actively engage in our society in the 21st century, which is threatened by climate change.

MOBILITIES as initially planned

18 pupils per country will take part in the Erasmus+ Project.

Each pupil participates in their school's Erasmus Meeting and in one Mobility abroad.

There will be four 5-day mobilities (LTTAs) on specific topics:

DEC 2020 – KÖLN

Joint staff training. The CLOCK is Ticking at School: Sustainability in our Teaching

Only for Teachers. The schools exchange examples of best-practice dealing with how they teach sustainability and how they tackle climate change in class and at school.

FEB 2021 - DESENZANO

Pupil exchange. The CLOCK is Ticking when Cooking

The meeting focuses on healthy and sustainable nutrition, sustainable cooking, the impact of different choices on our wellness and on the environment.

APR 2021 - ŁÓDŹ

Pupil exchange. The CLOCK Is Ticking in Everyday Life

The meeting focuses on how teenagers can live more sustainably e.g. by consuming less and reducing plastic and thus using less resources

OCT 2021 - ANDÚJAR

Pupil exchange. The CLOCK is Ticking within Resources

Students visit different sites of renewable energy at the meeting which are located close to the city of Andújar, namely biomass, hydroelectric, solar and wind.

MAY 2022 – KÖLN

Pupil exchange. The CLOCK is Ticking in Cities

The students will visit sustainable projects in the city to gain ideas as to what can be done to make a city greener.
